



Notice of Vacancies On the Parish Council

Coddenham Parish Council has eleven seats, of which four are vacant after the recent uncontested election of seven sitting councillors.

If you are interested in becoming a Parish Councillor and would like to be considered for co-option to one of the four vacant seats, you will find a copy of the co-option procedure and application forms on the Parish Website.

Please print a copy of the forms, complete the required details and either email a scanned copy or post a hard copy to the Parish Clerk. Please ensure that you meet the eligibility criteria before completing forms A and B.

Eligible candidates will be invited to address the next Parish Council meeting when the Council will consider the applications. Candidates will be required to gain more than 50% of the votes cast by councillors at the meeting in order to be co-opted on to the Council. If there are more applicants than seats available, a process of eliminating votes will determine which candidates will be co-opted.
